

## ITU Point Race, Copenhagen

The International Triathlon Union and The Danish Triathlon Federation has signed the first agreement to hold an ITU Triathlon Point Race in Copenhagen, Denmark. This is the first ITU Point Race in Scandinavia, and The Danish Triathlon Federation welcome all international athletes on June 29<sup>th</sup>.



The 2002 ITU International Triathlon event will be held at Charlottenlund Strandpark, at the beach and on the beautiful coastline just a little North of Copenhagen on Saturday, June the 29<sup>th</sup>.

### Race information

The race area is perfect suitable for triathlon races – both for athletes and audience.

The swim course will be two rounds on a triangular course. All the time close to the coast which allows the audience to follow the whole race from the beach. The transition zone is placed on the road less than 50 m. from the swim course and is a high speed transition zone.

The bike course is seven rounds on a flat 5,7 km course forth and back. Athletes can easily follow the competitors and the leaders can see the followers.

The run course which is a 4 round 2,5 km flat course forth and back from Charlottenlund Strandpark to Skovshoved Marina. The finish area is placed next to the transition area.

*“At that split second I was completely focused. I could feel sweat on the baton, I could see the finish line ahead of me, and I knew it was all mine”...*
